We would like to invite you to explore a different camping experience with us. We call them *Camp-n-Cabins* and we're proud of them.

These 12' X 12' rustic cabins are constructed of 1/2 log siding on concrete floors. A 5' X 12' covered porch provides shelter with a picturesque view for your relaxation

Your cabin comes complete with two bunk beds with mattresses, inside table and benches, picnic table, fire ring, electricity and water on site (where available), and a modern restroom building (with showers) located nearby for your convenience.

For a comfortable camping experience you should bring: sleeping bags or bed linens, toiletries, lantern, camp stove and cooking/eating utensils, extension cord (if you plan on using electricity), water hose, appropriate clothing, mosquito repellent and lots of enthusiasm.

Camp-n-Cabins are available at Paris, Merrill Lake, School Section Lake Veteran's and Brower Parks. Come sit awhile...you'll be glad you did.

NO PETS ALLOWED IN SCHOOL SECTION OR BROWER PARK

While enjoying the Mecosta County Parks. Please observe the following rules, as well as those listed on the back of your camping permit and the signs posted throughout the park. These rules are for your protection and to provide an enjoyable experience in our park.

- Extension on your Camp Permit must be made prior to 8:00 PM the day before the permit expires.
- Check out time is at 3:00 PM.
- Quiet hours begin at 10:00 PM. All guests must leave the park by 10:00 PM. Picnic and Paris Pond areas close at dark.
- Extinguish your campfire before retiring for the night.
- Speed limit in the parks is 10 mph.
- Absolutely no cutting or picking of any trees, shrubs, or wild flowers. (For locations of available firewood see the park rangers.)
- NO PETS ALLOWED IN ANY CABINS. Pets are allowed in Paris and Merrill parks only.
- Motorcycles are allowed in all Mecosta County Parks.
- Dishwater should be drained into a bucket or through a garden hose (sewer hose is not allowed). It should be emptied on the road or into the gray water drains where provided.

BROWER PARK

Brower Park offers ten camp-n-cabins, secluded within a forest of pine trees.

Situated along the Muskegon River, an excellent source for fishing or boating offering 280 acres with 240 campsites nestled right next to the Muskegon River.

Programming, modern restrooms, tennis courts, volleyball court, boat launch, and disc golf are just a few of the activities to explore at Brower.

Located in Stanwood (8 miles South of Big Rapids). Take exit 131 and go West on 8 Mile. Just past the BP gas station, turn South onto Old State road and follow Old State to our largest campground.

No pets are allowed at Brower, so please make other arrangements for the care of your pets during your stay.

SCHOOL SECTION LAKE VETERAN'S PARK

School Section Lake Veteran's Park offers five camp-n-cabins. The cabins overlook the lake and face West offering unforgettable sunsets. Nestled under a canopy of Oak, Maple and Poppel, our cabins provide a glimpse of nature from the front porch no matter what the weather.

The 85 acre park offers a great swimming beach, fishing, programming, modern restrooms, volleyball court, 10 HP boat launch, and disc golf are just a few of the activities to explore at School Section.

The park is located off M-20 at the intersection of 90th Ave. and 9 Mile road., South of the Village of Mecosta (approximately 6 miles West of Remus and M-66).



MERRILL LAKE PARK

Merrill Lake Park offers four camp-n-cabins set off from the main campground. Merrill Lake Park is situated between two lakes (Merrill Lake and Gorrel Lake) which makes it perfect for the fishing enthusiast.

Our "GEM" in the woods has 146 campsites on 90 acres, two beaches, playgrounds, boat launches, modern restrooms, picnic pavilions, horseshoes, baseball diamonds, and much more.

Merrill Lake Park is located three miles North of Barryton off M-66, approximately five miles South of U.S. 10.

PARIS PARK

Paris Park has three camp-n-cabins, which are a great spot for a quiet respite.

Situated along the Muskegon River, an excellent source of fishing, it offers 40 wooded acres with 68 campsites nestled under a broadleaf canopy, modern restrooms, volleyball court, canoe launch, plus the White Pine State Trail runs right through the park for those who like to bike, hike, or rollerblade.

Paris Park is located on old U.S. 131, six miles North of Big Rapids.
