Davis Bridge Park offers a serene environment to enjoy nature and have a picnic. For the guests that enjoy fishing, Davis Bridge offers a boat launch on the Muskegon River and parking for your vehicle and boat trailer.

Fee Pipe

If you already have your current annual stickers, you are welcome and ready to use the park. If you only wish to use the park on a daily basis, near the entrance to the park, you will find a fee pipe and envelope to insert your money in and then remove the portion that is to be placed on your dash to inform us you are a paid visitor and insert the remainder of the envelope (sealed) into the fee pipe provided.

Davis Bridge is on Consumers Energy Property and administered by the Mecosta County Park Commission.

Annual Vehicle and Annual Boat

The Mecosta County Park Commission offers an Annual Vehicle Sticker and an Annual Boat Sticker. These stickers are good for entrance into any Mecosta County Park Commission park including Davis Bridge Park. These stickers are available at Brower, School Section, Merrill and Paris Parks during the camping season. We also offer daily vehicle and daily boat permits. Every motorized vehicle and watercraft that enters the park must have an entrance sticker.

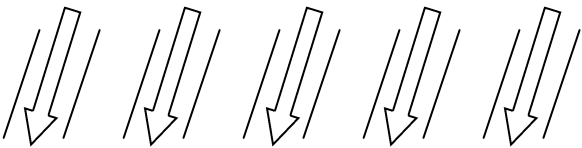
