

By Board action on May 18, 2005:

As a result of the emerald ash borer moratorium, campfire wood is only allowed to be brought into the Mecosta County Parks by an approved wood vendor. NO GUEST IS ALLOWED TO BRING IN ANY CAMPFIRE WOOD UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES. ANY GUEST FOUND TO BE IN VIOLATION WILL BE IMMEDIATELY EVICTED FROM THE PARK.

No more than 1 rick to be delivered to any one campsite.

ABSOLUTELY NO ASH WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE PARKS
